# <u>Jr High Jazz Students Lessons - Lesson 4</u>

#### 1 – Warm ups: 5 minutes

Mouthpiece, lip slurs/long tones

## 2 - Technique: 10-15 minutes

- Ab Major in swing 8th notes to the 9th scale degree
- Think about tonguing the upbeats and slurring into the downbeat
- Do Dah oo Dah oo, etc.

- Cinstruments Ab Bb C Db E F G Ab Bb
- Bb instruments Bb C D Eb F G A Bb C
- Ebinstruments F G A Bb C D E F G

- Harmonic minor scales are really just the parent major scale starting on the 6<sup>th</sup> scale degree. We then alter the new 7<sup>th</sup> note by raising it a semitone. This gives a leading tone into the root.

### Bb Major = G Harmonic minor example

#### 3 - Rep: 10-30 minutes

- Listen to the piece you're working on. Most band pieces are available to listen to on <u>jwpepper.com</u> or <u>YouTube</u>.
- o Listen and finger along.
- o Listen and play along don't worry about mistakes.
- o Isolate the more difficult passages and work on these in small "chunks."
  - Without playing, figure out the **rhythms** first. Write in the counting
    if you need to and if need be, S L O W it way down. <u>Accuracy is</u>
    more important than speed.
  - Look at the notes and add the fingerings to the rhythms you've just learned.
  - Take note of the key signature and any accidentals; play these small "chunks" sections on your instrument. <u>Accuracy is more</u> <u>important than speed.</u>

- o Put the "chunks" together, gradually increasing tempo if necessary. <u>Accuracy is more important than speed.</u>
- o Practice with a metronome is always encouraged.

## 4 - Soloing: 10-30 minutes

- Continue your work with Bb Major and minor blues scales. Once you have 4 measures, make 4 more and 4 more. You want to fill your bag with as many tricks as possible.
